The extremely well maintained Middle Ages monastery is situated in South Germany near to the city of Sigmaringen. The accommodation made available is in the modern and tastefully renovated cells once occupied by the nuns. The meeting is open for all.

Our focus is on getting to know one another and the sharing of ideas – a core idea of ILBS. There will be themes and activities of interest, which should be both relaxing and enthralling. Planned activities include a guided tour of the Monastery buildings, live music, several workshops and much more. The event will be offered in English and Germany and one is free to choose between various events running parallel. We are open for any suggestions and organisational offers for further events.

Arrival: Friday 15th May 2009 from 9:00. Lunch together at 12:00. Departure: Sunday 17th May 2009 after afternoon coffee.

We have reserved a block of rooms for you but as soon as these have been taken we cannot guarantee accommodation in the monastery. Alternatively you will be booked into a nearby hotel with shower and WC. Therefore it is necessary to book as early as possible if you want to stay in the nuns apartments. The total costs for **full board and lodging and attendance fee** are as follows:

Twin bed room €120 pro Person

Twin bed room with shower and WC €150 per person

Single room €150

Single room with shower and WC €170 (limited number of rooms, alternatively in hotels).
