
**Re: WSBA CPE Proposed Draft Opinion 2223 – NOTICE – Comment Period Extended
– Public Session Set**

At its meeting on October 26, 2018, the WSBA Committee on Professional Ethics decided to **extend the comment deadline for the proposed draft opinion to January 15, 2019**. If you have already submitted a comment, there is no need to do so again. If you would like to submit new comments, please do so before the deadline. Comments may be submitted via email at WSBACPE@wsba.org.

The CPE will hold a **90-minute listening session on the proposed draft opinion during its regular meeting on February 22, 2019**, at the WSBA offices, 1325 4th Avenue, Suite 600, Seattle, Washington. The session is expected to begin **at 10:30 a.m.** The purpose of the session is to provide a Q&A and exchange viewpoints with stakeholders regarding the contents of the CPE-proposed draft of a revised Advisory Opinion 2223. The CPE believes the session will bring clarification to views expressed in comments it has received.
